NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules*: Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-2004 with US SAILING Prescriptions, this Notice of Race (except as changed by the Sailing Instructions), and the Sailing Instructions. The Class Rules of the Atlantic Class will apply. The regatta is classified a Category A event.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 High School teams are invited to apply, members of which are current or past students at that school. Any qualified current or former high school sailor (of any ISAF Class) is eligible to apply and will be placed on a team if not entering with others as a school team. The 14 schools which sailed in the *First Annual Interscholastic Regatta* have priority in entering teams : Choate, Hotchkiss, Kent, Lawrenceville, Middlesex, Morristown, Pomfret, Roxbury, St. George's, St. Mark's, St. Paul's, Tabor, Taft and Westminster. A team is comprised of a minimum of 3 qualified sailors with no maximum. Sailors should attend or have attended the same high school. Teams comprised of current high school students must be accompanied by a designated adult Team-Leader/ Chaperone who may sail with the team. The school winning the 2004 Mallory (ISSA National High School Doublehanded Championship) is invited to enter. The Mallory family will participate as an entry. The ISSA Board of Directors will sponsor an entry.

2.2 Selection of competing school teams for the ISSA 75th Anniversary Interscholastic Regatta is by invitation. The regatta has 16 boat-team berths, 14 of which are available to the 14 schools that competed in the first interscholastic regatta in June of 1930. Invitations have been sent to

those original schools. Additional invitations will be issued by ISSA based on responses and applications.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

3.1 Invited schools teams enter by submitting an Official Entry Form(appendd) and two separate checks made out to "ISSA", one for the entry fee and one for the boat damage deposit with the Regatta Registration Chairperson by May 20, 2004. Individuals wishing to sail on a team or to be involved in this celebration can submit an entry as an individual, paying for meals alone. Late entries may be accommodated if space permits, on a first-come basis.

3.2 Sailing Instructions will be available at on-site registration on June 10th.

4. ENTRY FEE

There will be an entry fee of \$75 per team member and \$25 per team for regatta support This fee includes lunch and the "formal" dinner on Thursday the 10th, a BBQ dinner on Friday the 11th, and breakfasts and lunches on June 11th and Saturday the 12th. Additional tickets for the dinners may be purchased, at the time of pre-registration for \$50.

5. BOATS

Atlantic Class keel sloops will be provided by the members of the Cedar Point YC Atlantic Fleet. The boat owner or representative will be aboard each day of the regatta and can sail in any position except Skipper. Boats will be assigned by drawing and will not be rotated. Team member substitutions may be arranged from a Spectator Boat on the course, at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

6. BOAT DAMAGE DEPOSIT

A refundable boat damage deposit of \$250 must be submitted with each entry. In the event that damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly between all the teams competing.

Changes to this schedule will be posted on the Notice Board by 2000 the day before they take effect.

8. RACING AREA

All races will be sailed south of Cedar Point Yacht Club in Long Island Sound.

9. COURSES

Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses. Windward/leeward courses are expected.

10. SCORING

The regatta will be scored using RRS App. A. Five races are scheduled, three constitute a series. No race scores will be excluded. The Low Point System (A4.1) will be used.

11. HOUSING

Teams are responsible for their own housing. A list of area accommodations can be found on Addendum I to the NOR.

12. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
