

Notice of Race

**ISSA National Open Invitational Regatta  
15-16 October, 2005  
U.S. Coast Guard Academy, New London, CT**

1. Rules: This regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and *The Procedural Rules for Interscholastic Competition*.
2. Format: Two divisions (two skippers, two crews, plus substitutes) per school; eighteen teams; a single round-robin will be attempted and a boat rotation will be posted prior to the competitors meeting.
3. Boats: 420s and FJs as supplied by the U.S. Coast Guard Academy; divisions will switch fleets at or approximately half way through the regatta.
4. Report Time: 0900 on Saturday, 15 October, 2005. Competitors meeting NLT 0930.
5. Last Race: No race will start after 1530 on Sunday, 16 October, 2005
6. Housing and Meals: Will be the responsibility of each team. Please bring lunch materials with you since teams will not leave the Academy grounds during racing hours.
7. Parking: Team vehicles may be parked on Eagle Drive along the waterfront. Each vehicle may be required to show license and registration. In addition, all competitors should be prepared to show a photo ID to the security officer at the front gate.
8. Eligibility: ISSA Member Teams must meet the eligibility requirements of the Inter-Scholastic Sailing Association.
9. Berths: Teams apply for berths to the organizers. Berths will be filled by the organizers according to the following District allocation: MASSA – 2; MWISA – 1; NESSA – 3; NWISA – 1; PCISA – 1; SAISA – 2; SEISA – 1  
At-Large – the remaining 7 berths will be awarded on a first come, first served basis after District allocations are filled.  
Allocated District berths not filled by 1 October will be filled from the list of teams waiting on the “first come” list.
