Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Racing will be umpired.
- 1.3. Competitors shall wear adequate personal buoyancy.
- 1.4. Right of appeal will be denied.
- 1.5. Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to, the event.
- 1.6. Generally, teams shall not change after registration.

2. Entries

- 2.1. Entries will be accepted from teams of six to sail in three-boat teams in Feva dinghies (without spinnakers) supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.2. All competitors will be under 16 on 31st December 2005.
- 2.3. The entry fee is £115.
- 2.4. Each team will lodge a damage deposit of £200.
 - a. Cheques shall be deposited on registration. They will be destroyed at the end of the event if no damage has been incurred.
 - b. £200 is the limit of liability for any one incident.
 - c. Unreported damage will be charged to the teams who have used the boat before the damage was discovered unless those who caused the damage are identified.
 - d. If a deduction is made following an incident a further cheque to restore the deposit may be required before a team may continue.
- 2.5. The closing date for entries is 4th November 2005.
- 2.6. The event will be restricted to 24 teams. If more than 24 teams enter the RYA will determine and use a method of choosing 24.
- 2.7. Entries shall include an email address that will be used for notices and information. A subsequent change of email address must be acknowledged by the RYA to be effective.
- 2.8. Team organisers shall ensure that the prescribed parent/guardian declaration form (available on the website) is completed, signed and given to the organisers at registration.

3. Sailing instructions, registration and briefing

- 3.1. Sailing instructions and briefing notes will be posted on the website by 4th November. Questions on them by email are invited before the event. The answered questions will be posted on the website until 10th November after which they will be posted on the notice board at the event.
- 3.2. Registration will be from 0830 on Saturday 12th November.
- 3.3. There will be a briefing at 0900 on Saturday.

4. Racing programme

- 4.1. Racing will start at 0930 on Saturday and continue all day. It will resume at 0800 on Sunday and continue until the middle of the afternoon.
- 4.2. A round robin will be sailed until some time on Sunday when the boats with most wins will go through to a final knock-out stage.

5. Liability exclusion

- 5.1. Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility.
- 5.2. By going out to race, competitors confirm they are competent to sail and compete in the prevailing conditions.
- 5.3. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of competitors taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event.
- 5.4. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve competitors of their responsibilities.

Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Racing will be umpired.
- 1.3. Competitors shall wear adequate personal buoyancy.
- 1.4. Right of appeal will be denied.
- 1.5. Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to, the event.
- 1.6. Generally, teams shall not change after registration.

2. Entries

- 2.1. Entries will be accepted from teams of six to sail in three-boat teams in Firefly dinghies supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.2. All competitors will be under 19 on 31st December 2005.
- 2.3. The entry fee is £115.
- 2.4. Each team will lodge a damage deposit of £200.
 - a. Cheques shall be deposited on registration. They will be returned at the end of the event if no damage has been incurred.
 - b. £200 is the limit of liability for any one incident.
 - c. Unreported damage will be charged to the teams who have used the boat before the damage was discovered unless those who caused the damage are identified.
 - d. If a deduction is made following an incident a further cheque to restore the deposit may be required before a team may continue.
- 2.5. The closing date for entries is 4th November 2005.
- 2.6. The event will be restricted to 24 teams. If more than 24 teams enter the RYA will determine and use a method of choosing 24.
- 2.7. Entries shall include an email address that will be used for notices and information. A subsequent change of email address must be acknowledged by the RYA to be effective.
- 2.8. Team organisers shall ensure that the prescribed parent/guardian declaration form (available on the website) is completed, signed and given to the organisers at registration in respect of any member of their team who was born after 11th November 1987.
