

**Updates to ISSA Procedural Rules- 9/9/01**

Change 7.7 (a) to:

7.7 Courses

- (a) All courses, if possible, shall be laid out so that the first leg is a beat to windward. Triangles and windward-leeward courses with the start/ finish line in the middle of the windward leg are always acceptable, as are variations of the two (see Appendix 7). For team racing, Appendix 6 and Appendix 7 offer acceptable alternative courses.

Change to 9 (c) to:

- (c) A boat disabled (unless granted compensation) or not finishing for any other reason (DNF), or a boat that has not complied with RRS 29.1 or 30.1 (OCS) shall be scored ONE point more than the number of competing teams in the division. A boat that does not start (DNS) or retires after finishing (RET) shall be scored TWO points more than the number of competing teams in the division. A boat that is disqualified after a hearing (DSQ) shall be scored FOUR points more than the number of competing teams in the division. (Changes RRS A4.2).
